Thrive in 5 Releases Evaluator Request for Proposals

Proposals due December 16

Today, Thrive in 5 released an **Evaluator Request for Proposals** seeking an external evaluator to:

- design and implement an evaluation of the Community School Readiness Wiring initiative (funded by the W.K. Kellogg Foundation);
- design an evaluation plan for Thrive in 5 building on the Thrive in 5 logic model, and current and planned implementation work; and
- support coordination of evaluations of individual implementation projects with one another and with Thrive in 5 overall.

The total contract amount from this RFP is \$200,000. The contract, issued by United Way of Massachusetts Bay and Merrimack Valley as the fiscal agent for Thrive in 5, will begin in February 2010 and will end June 30, 2011.

Key Dates & Deadlines

- November 30, 2009 - Letters of Intent to Apply Due (*optional, but encouraged*)
- December 4, 2009 - Bidders' Questions Due (*In lieu of a live bidders' conference, all questions received by December 4th will be posted anonymously as they are submitted on our website. Responses to all questions received will be posted by Tuesday, December 8th at noon.*)
- December 16, 2009 - Proposals Due
- Week of January 11 & 18, 2010 - Interviews with Finalists
- Mid-February 2010 - Notification of Award
